

## Maths

### Multiplication and Division

We will continue learning times tables and learning fact families. The children will be encouraged to reason about numbers and explaining their answers

### Measuring – Length and Height.

The children will learn to measure in cm and m and will estimate and compare length and height

### Mass, capacity and temperature

We will learn to use grams, kilograms, litres, millilitres, comparing solving problems,

## English

**Texts:** The Owl and the Pussycat and Tadpole's promise. The children will make predictions and explore different sentences focussing on vocabulary used by the author. They will write their own sentences using noun phrases. When writing independently, they will plan their writing and will be encouraged to edit it to make improvements.

**Reading:** Continuing phonics for decoding and comprehension of what has been read. **Spellings:** The children will be practising Year 1 and 2 words and spelling patterns – please continue to log in to Spelling Shed for your child's spellings.

## DT – moving vehicles

We will research moving vehicles, learning about inventors of the past. The children will explore joining materials, making axles and design their vehicle. Once made, the children will evaluate their finished piece and think about how it could be improved.

### China

## Computing

The children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

## Geography

Through our topic of 'China' we will compare life here in the UK to China, looking at traditions and culture. The children will learn about Beijing and London and make comparisons between the 2 cities studying physical and human features.

## Music/French

Music – Year 2 are taking their first steps with instruments and learn how music is written and played.

French – The children will continue to learn about Harry and his trip to France. They have looked at shops that can be found in a French town and they will be looking into shopping at the bakery, finding out which coins to use and how to ask for things.

## Science

The topic of animals including humans continues from last half term. This half term we explore more about keeping healthy, clean and having a healthy mind. We will link this to PSHE activities and our visit from the Life Education team.

## RE

### Christianity

Traditions and beliefs, the children will learn about the build up to Easter and the Easter story.

## PSHE

Alongside all our PSHE is the well-being of our children. We encourage the children to always share their problems so they are happy and ready to learn.

### Invasion games

Finding space, avoiding capture, teamwork and using equipment will be explored.
