

English: Reading into Writing

- ◇ Texts: *The bear and the piano* and *The bear under the stairs*. We will explore and develop writing skills for both fiction and non-fiction writing. We will write questions, statements and learn to develop the quality of our sentences using noun phrases and begin to edit our own work.
- ◇ Reading: Continuing phonics for decoding and comprehension of what has been read.
- ◇ Spellings: We will be practising Year 1 and 2 words and spelling patterns – please continue to log in to Spelling Shed for your child's spellings.

Maths

- ◇ We will be introduced to multiplication where we will be looking at grouping and then the multiplication symbol. We will also explore division, and how we can use these related facts to solve problems.
- ◇ We will then learn about Shape and continue with Addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers.

Science

ANIMALS INCLUDING HUMANS: We will be exploring what offspring is, developing our understanding of our and other's basic needs for survival, and the importance of exercise.

- ◇ Gymnastics; we will be exploring a range of gymnastic skills with Mr Noyce.

History
